- There was a positive view on increasing the geographical area to include Sandhurst and Crowthorne.
- There is a wonderful opportunity to provide a cohesive plan that allows for a calendar of Masses and events to meet the demand of the larger area.
- Create a community with a sense of belonging with greater opportunities for growth
- A change program to tie the larger community together that is sensitive to each of the current parishes' cultures
- There is a need to understand risk and assumptions that will need to be managed and taken account of.
- Learn from other communities as to how they have organised themselves and brought communities together.
- By keeping to Diocesan guidelines how inventive and inspirational can we be.
- Consideration of the logistics of the larger area including for example available public transport when arranging services and other activity, use of technology for meetings etc.
- New administration and support structures to meet the need and demand from the new pastoral area geographical size.
- Events that are age specific, to be conscious of worries about large gatherings and groups meeting for many this has become an increased worry with COVID-19

4 Is there any more feedback that the parish would like to add

- Encourage Religious to be in the new geographical area e.g. nuns and other Religious.
- Need for a Catholic Secondary School for the new geographical area
- Need to be more aware of everyone's needs and to be encouraged to join the various groups and structures
- Review entry requirements to the priesthood and consider is the bar to high.
- Be brave and bold allow women priests and deacons, Catholic married priests, part time priests.
- Church should be messy church and encourage the marginalised and vulnerable to come and see/ join. Need to enthuse everyone to consider getting to know more people across different Masses and to talk to others around them rather than rush off and not be seen until the next weekend.
- Clear understandable messages are needed including the plan itself we need to learn that poor communication has historically led to some parishioners leave and not return.
- Change is hard, but the opportunity is huge in invigorating the church i.e. us the people
- Wide view and perspective provided by a wide group of people. The Diocese needs to
 ensure we stick to our core principles and not dilute to try and use this dilution to attract
 more people.
- Concern about larger gatherings and meetings. Events and worries heightened arising from COVID-19
- Marriage guidance and counselling is sorely needed married clergy would be a help here?
- Young couples need support and would welcome a secure and safe babysitting service

- Safe and secure space and organised groups for young people and others so that they could come together and share faith experience
- Will parishes be consulted with regard to clergy in the new pastoral area?
- There were practical suggestions regarding how best to move forward with all aspects of new pastoral area organisation and structure; sacramental preparation; Mass and other liturgical services; groups and pastoral support; best practice; how lay involvement could be mobilised; looking to the Diocese to provide practical and realistic leadership that will need to be considered at the next stage.
- Finance and costs were raised as an aspect requiring attention.
- Property Management and the need for a clear and unambiguous strategy.
- A significant shift in everyone providing their time, talent and treasure is required to achieve the vision. (Look to Divine Renovation as a blueprint).
