# **Notes to Accounts**

- Currently agreeing the final account and proceeds from the sale of St Margaret Clitherow church site, once received details will be published. The flat roof repair was undertaken as a loan against proceeds of sale and will be reported on as part of this report.
- 2. The cost of the repair to the hall arising from the storm damage was carried out through an insurance claim and isnot included in the parish accounts.
- 3. The parish are awaiting final details from the Diocese regarding Living Our Faith Campaign. A big thank you to all who donated to this fund previously.
- 4. The Diocese Year End is now the 31<sup>st</sup> December so the next year end finance presentation will be during Spring 2025 for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024. This will be a new style parish stakeholder report.
- 5. The Diocese has introduced a common accounting system across the Diocese based on the IT package called XERO.
- 6. Please be aware that the parish accounts are on a cash basis. This can lead to timing of events i.e. receipt or payment of monies impacting the finance reports year on year.
- 7. There will be a presentation regarding the need to raise monies for the Diocesan Closer to Christ Campaign at the beginning of Lent. This is a specific request for the parish to raise £147,400 over five years to cover the cost of priests retirement, priest formation and training etc.
- 8. For confidentiality reasons any expenditure or income that involves a parishioner or uniquely identifies an individual has been excluded from this report.
