Main Points from Group Notes

- 1. Need to" get on with it."
- 2. Clergy need to be visible across the whole pastoral area and be seen and known by the whole area.
- 3. Form a senior leadership and other key teams to progress the plan.
- 4. Active groups should become single cross church groups and work together.
- 5. Joint fundraising for pastoral area initiatives
- 6. Joint formation activities
- 7. Common Approach to how we do things, bringing together the distinct groups, set up meetings for each parish group to work out how they would work together.
- 8. Need to train people and have training programs for the pastoral area.
- 9. Use technology to ensure everyone has access to the larger, bigger, parish e.g. use of life streaming, social media, teams, zoom etc.
- 10. Need an inclusion plan for all activity e.g. need to have programs that allow all to access sacraments, groups, etc.
- 11. Need a joint communications plan i.e. newsletter, web site, social media, etc.
- 12. All activity wherever possible should be pastoral area driven.
- 13. Social program to get to know everyone e.g. picnics, pastoral area outdoor mass, quiz nights.
- 14. Recruitment of younger people and them being allowed to be active in church roles.
- 15. Need for succession planning.
- 16. Need for a matrix of roles and demographic of each parish e.g. use Parish Life document.
- 17. Must make sure that all our schools, hospitals etc are supported and we are seen to be supportive, and all have an active place within the parish.
- 18. Barriers to be aware of:
 - Maintaining momentum and enthusiasm
 - Transport to venues for those who do not have access.
 - Time and commitment of individuals
 - Faculty authority to be new parish wide than just existing parish structure.
 - Diverse ways of doing things in each parish and reluctance to change.
 - Buildings and capacity
 - Multiple sites
 - Communication essential to make sure all feel included.
 - Recruitment of volunteers at each existing parish
 - Distances between churches
